## THE BARNWELL MIDSUMMER FAIR (CAMBRIDGE CITY) ORDER 2000

WHEREAS the fair of Barnwell commonly known as the Midsummer Fair ("the Fair") is used to be held in the City of Cambridge from 2.30pm (or such earlier hour as may be proclaimed by the Mayor) on the third Wednesday in June or, if the third Wednesday falls on 15th, 16th or 17th June, the fourth Wednesday in June and continuing for the four days (exclusive of Sunday) next following the day of commencement and no longer, and representation has been duly made to the Secretary of State by Cambridge City Council being the owner of the Fair, that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that the Fair be held in each year from 2.30pm (or such earlier hour as may be proclaimed by the Mayor) on the third Wednesday in June or, if the third Wednesday falls on 15th, 16th or 17th June, the fourth Wednesday in June and shall continue for the five days (inclusive of Sunday) next following the day of commencement and no longer.

AND WHEREAS notice of the said representation and of the time when the same would be taken into consideration by the Secretary of State has been duly given and published in pursuance of section 6 of the Fairs Act 1873 as modified by section 27 of the Local Government Act 1894 (56 and 57 Vict. c. 73):

AND WHEREAS it appears to the Secretary of State, after considering the said representation, that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that the Fair be held in each year from 2.30pm (or such earlier hour as may be proclaimed by the Mayor) on the third Wednesday in June or, if the third Wednesday falls on 15th, 16th or 17th June, the fourth Wednesday in June and shall continue for the five days (inclusive of Sunday) next following the day of commencement and no longer.

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 6 of the Fairs Act 1873, hereby orders that the <u>fair of Barnwell</u>, commonly known as

the Midsummer Fair shall be held in each year from 2.30pm (or such earlier hour as may be proclaimed by the Mayor) on the third Wednesday in June or, if the third Wednesday falls on 15th, 16th or 17th June, the fourth Wednesday in June and shall continue for the five days (inclusive of Sunday) next following the day of commencement and no longer.
