

NEW BIT COMMON

Cambridge City Council and Cambridgeshire County Council have applied to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for consent under section 38 of the Commons Act 2006 to carry out restricted works on New Bit Common.

The proposed works relate to the 290 metre length section of path from the junction with Trumpington Road to the bench at the fork in the path. The works are to i) widen this narrow section from 1.5 metres to 2.5 metres in width and ii) install an additional cattle grid with associated fencing at the entrance adjacent to Trumpington Road.

A copy of the application form and map showing the proposed works can be inspected at the Guildhall Planning Reception between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm weekdays (not public holidays) until the 14th September 2009.
